## Already doing to support Young Carers

BPL have run events for Young Carers twice a year (Easter and Christmas) since 2018, in collaboration with Focus on Young People in Bassetlaw and the Young Carers Notts Service. They have also funded gym memberships for Young Carers.

They have an Easter event coming up on the 27<sup>th</sup> March for Young Carers under 14 with various Easter crafts and an entertainer. They obtain funding, along with FOYPIB, from local rotary clubs etc. to run these events and do all of the organising with FOYPIB. The Young Carers Notts Service then provides the Young Carers to attend.

## All necessary staff have received YC Awareness training

Angela Dainty (Health and Wellbeing manager), Nicola Boswell (Marketing Executive) and Suzanne Chambers (operations and administration) received the Young Carer Awareness Training in February 2024.

Angela is going to encourage other staff members to join in the Young Carer Awareness training when I next have a webinar planned. This will probably be sometime in May 2024.
